



EACC Site Meeting Agenda (October ?, 2015)

What was discussed at the EACC Representative Assembly last time? (8 minutes)

- On October 3, 2015, the NEA Board of Directors voted to endorse **Hillary Clinton** in the Primary Elections.
- **SLO Deadlines** – All pretest data was uploaded to Fast Test on/before 10-9. Draft SLOs are due 10-21. Final SLOs are due 10-30.
- **Extra Duty for Extra Pay** – All salary items, including EPED positions, must be negotiated. EPEDs listed in the agreement are the only positions eligible for a stipend. Any other clubs, teams, etc. should not be getting stipends, as they have not been negotiated and are most likely not being given across the school system. It’s done this way to ensure equity.
- **Walk Throughs** – Walk throughs are allowed, but do not count towards your evaluation. There is a separate tab for WT in Insystech. They are intended to provide feedback on things you’re doing well and things that may need some work. They are intended to be supportive. If the WT uncovers concerns, the principal may come back for an actual observation, which could count towards an evaluation. Administration has the right to observe you, announced or unannounced, as many times as they would like.
- **Print Shop** – Please continue to let the EACC rep/s know of print shop issues/concerns so that we can get them addressed.
- **Early Dismissal Days** – Unit I employees are allowed to work from an alternate location. You are only required to tell the administration if you are working off-site; you are not required to tell them where you are working. If you plan to a whole day of leave on an ED day, you are required to report a full day of leave (7.5 hours) and not subtract the 2 hours of planning time. If you plan to take a half-day of leave (PM), you are required report a half-day of leave (3.75 hours) and not subtract the 2 hours of planning time.
- **Mary Finneran**, V.P. at Dr. Brown Elementary School is the new **Unit II Representative on the EACC Executive Board**.
