### Primary Election

<b>June 28<sup>th</sup></b>	Final day to register or amend voter registration
<b>July 12<sup>th</sup></b>	Requests for mail in ballots must be received
<b>July 19<sup>th</sup></b>	Mail-in ballots must be postmarked or placed in a designated drop box by 8 PM
<b>July 7<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup></b>	Early voting window
<b>July 19<sup>th</sup></b>	Primary Election Day

### General Election

<b>October 18<sup>th</sup></b>	Final day to register or amend voter registration
<b>November 1<sup>st</sup></b>	Requests for mail in ballots must be received
<b>November 8<sup>th</sup></b>	Mail-in ballots must be postmarked or placed in a designated drop box by 8 PM
<b>October 22<sup>nd</sup> - November 3<sup>rd</sup></b>	Early voting window
<b>November 8<sup>th</sup></b>	General Election Day

# Voter Checklist

## PRIMARY ELECTION

- Check that you are [registered to vote](#) at your current address
  - If you are not registered, [register](#) by June 28<sup>th</sup>
- If desired, [request a mail-in ballot](#) by July 12<sup>th</sup>  
*(This is a good option if you will be traveling, can't vote in person or would prefer to vote by mail.)*
- Keep an eye out in the mail for your sample ballot. Review the candidates and ballot format. Use the [MSEA Apple Ballot voter guide](#) to identify pro-public education candidates on your ballot.
- Make a Voting Plan  
*(Highlight or circle the method you plan to use below.)*
  - **Mail-in Ballot:** Must be postmarked or dropped off at a designated drop box by 8 PM on July 19<sup>th</sup>
  - **Early In-Person Voting:** Visit a [designated early voting center](#) July 7<sup>th</sup> - July 14<sup>th</sup> between 7 AM and 8 PM
  - **In-Person Voting:** Look up your [assigned polling location](#) and its hours. Report to your polling location to vote on July 19<sup>th</sup>.
